Purpose of Update

To update phrase translations for all supported* languages in line with changes published in COMMISSION REGULATION (EU) No 487/2013 of 8th May, 2013.

*Only languages of EU member countries are supported for legislative changes. Phrase amendments for languages of non-EU countries are subject to availability.

The following lists summarise the changes covered by this update (shown in English only but all applicable user languages will be updated).

The following codes are deleted and replaced:

P285	<i>Replaced by P284ex (see codes added).</i>
P307+P311	<i>Replaced by P308+311 (see codes added).</i>

In the following phrases the wording has been altered:

H223	Flammable aerosol.
P210	Keep away from heat, hot surfaces, sparks, open flames and other ignition sources. No smoking.
P223	Do not allow contact with water.
P244	Keep valves and fittings free from oil and grease.
P251	Do not pierce or burn, even after use.
P284	[In case of inadequate ventilation] wear respiratory protection.
P310	Immediately call a POISON CENTER/doctor/...
P311	Call a POISON CENTER/ doctor/...
P312	Call a POISON CENTER/ doctor/.../if you feel unwell.
P340	Remove person to fresh air and keep comfortable for breathing.
P352	Wash with plenty of water/...



P361	Take off immediately all contaminated clothing.
P362	Take off contaminated clothing.
P378	Use ... to extinguish.
P301+P310	IF SWALLOWED: Immediately call a POISON CENTER/doctor/...
P301+P312	IF SWALLOWED: Call a POISON CENTER/doctor/.../if you feel unwell.
P302+P352	IF ON SKIN: Wash with plenty of water/...
P303+P361+P353	IF ON SKIN (or hair): Take off immediately all contaminated clothing. Rinse skin with water/ shower.
P304+P340	IF INHALED: Remove person to fresh air and keep comfortable for breathing.
P342+P311	If experiencing respiratory symptoms: Call a POISON CENTER/doctor/...
P370+P378	In case of fire: Use ... to extinguish.

The following phrases are added to the list:

H229	Pressurised container: May burst if heated.
H230	May react explosively even in the absence of air.
H231	May react explosively even in the absence of air at elevated pressure and/or temperature.
P284ex*	In case of inadequate ventilation wear respiratory protection. (<i>optional expanded form of P284</i>).
P308+P11	IF exposed or concerned: Call a POISON CENTER/ doctor/...
P364	Wash contaminated clothing before reuse.
P361+P364	Take off immediately all contaminated clothing and wash it before reuse.
P362+P364	Take off contaminated clothing and wash it before reuse.

*P284ex is **not** an official code but has been adopted by Hibiscus PLC to differentiate between the short form of P284 (stored as P284) and the extended form (stored as P284ex).

CHANGES TO SUBSTANCE DATA

Changes to wording of phrases will automatically be picked up by substance records **except** where user derivations (eg. wildcard completions) of those phrases have been stored against individual substances or as new phrases in the phrase table with an altered code.

In addition, the update will **optionally**:

1. Remove all references to deleted codes from all substance records.
2. Replace all references to replaced codes with references to the replacement code.

NB: New codes will **NOT** be added to any substance records. It is the user's responsibility to determine where and if the new codes apply to their substances.

USER DERIVATIONS AND WILDCARDS

User derivations of any of the phrases affected by this update and stored using variations of the original code will NOT be affected by the update.

Variations and wildcard completions of phrases stored against individual substances will not be affected even though the base copy of the phrase may change.
